

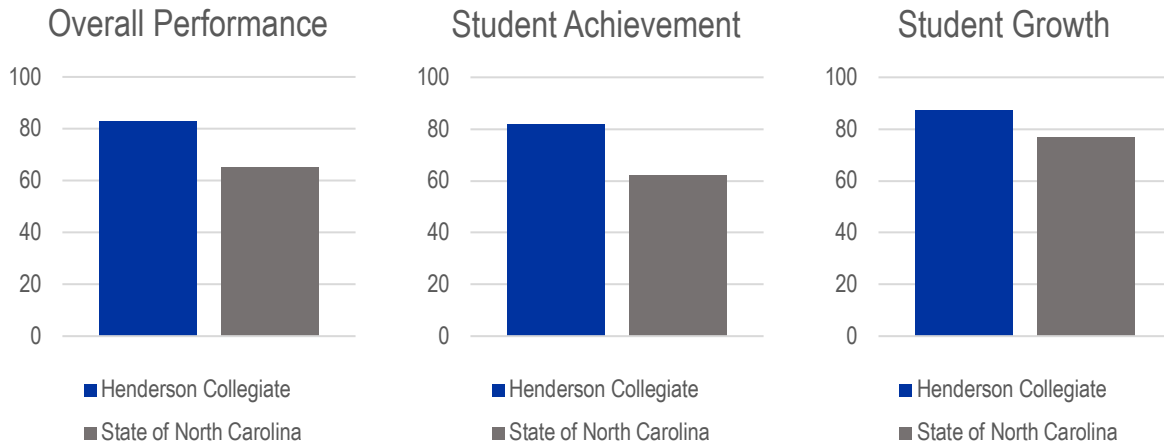
Henderson Collegiate: Our 2018 - 2019 Performance

In the 2018-2019 school year, with the hard work of our students, staff, and families, we were able to accomplish that.

Two of the biggest goals that we have every school year center around our students' growth and college acceptance. These goals demonstrate that the program is working and moving toward our biggest goal of college graduation. As detailed in the bullets below, last year, our results were extraordinary in both of these categories:

1. Last year was the 9th consecutive year that Henderson Collegiate exceeded its expected growth.
2. 100% of the Pride of 2019 were accepted into a 4-year college or university.

In order to earn the reputation for being a school with an excellent academic program, it is also important to compare our program at the State level. Below you can see how Henderson Collegiate outperformed the State:



With everything that there is to be proud of, we know there still is growth to make. We earned a school performance grade of a B last year after four consecutive years of earning an A. Although we were just two points away from earning an A, and knowing part of the reason for this decrease lies with the implementation of a new math test, on which students were not permitted to retest, as well as on new requirements around online testing, we also believe that there is work to be done in order to produce higher student achievement results. This year, we are excited to be focusing on content-specific professional development for our teachers, growing our reading program, revamping our math curriculum, and providing more AP support for both our teachers and our students.

At Henderson Collegiate, we know that if you want more, you have to do more. With the hardest working staff in the country, students who relentlessly pursue their goals, and parents who hold their children to the highest of expectations, this year will once again be another huge step toward all of our students attending and graduating from college of their choice.
