

NOTICE REGARDING AHERA REGULATIONS

TO: ALL HENDERSON COLLEGIATE FAMILIES AND STAFF

RE: REQUIRED ANNUAL AHERA NOTIFICATIONS
DATE: AUGUST 2019

The US Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA) Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA) requires all schools to inspect building materials for the presence of asbestos. AHERA excludes schools from the inspection requirement if the school was constructed after October 12, 1988, and has a signed statement from the architect or project engineer responsible for constructing the school stating that no asbestos-containing materials were specified for use in the construction/manufacturing of the school. Our school has been provided such a statement, and is, therefore, exempt from the requirement to conduct an asbestos inspection.

The EPA requires us to annually notify you that we are aware of the AHERA regulation, and that we are compliant. The Management Plan is available for your review at any time during normal school hours (Monday – Friday, 7:30 AM – 5:00 PM).
